PROCEDURE RS-28	SUBJECT: CUSTOM VEHICLE AND STREET ROD LICENSE PLATES

DESCRIPTION AND USE:

THIS PROCEDURE PROVIDES INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS TO ASSIST TAX COLLECTOR EMPLOYEES, LICENSE PLATE AGENT EMPLOYEES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES WITH THE ISSUANCE OF CUSTOM VEHICLE AND STREET ROD LICENSE PLATES.

I. PROVISIONS OF LAW:

[Section 319.14\(1\)\(c\)11a and b, Florida Statutes](#), defines a “custom vehicle” as a motor vehicle that is 25 years old or older and of a model year after 1948 or was manufactured to resemble a vehicle that is 25 years old or older and of a model year after 1948; and has been altered from the manufacturer's original design or has a body constructed from non-original materials.

[Section 319.14\(1\)\(c\)12a and b, Florida Statutes](#), defines a “street rod” as a motor vehicle that is of a model year of 1948 or older or was manufactured after 1948 to resemble a vehicle of a model year of 1948 or older; and has been altered from the manufacturer's original design or has a body constructed from non-original materials.

[Section 320.0863, Florida Statutes](#), provides for registration of custom vehicles and street rods.

II. GENERAL INFORMATION FOR CUSTOM VEHICLES:

- A.** The model year and year of manufacture that the body of a custom vehicle resembles is the model year and year of manufacture listed on the certificate of title, regardless of when the vehicle was actually manufactured.
- B.** Custom vehicle license plates may only be issued for motor vehicles that are 25 years of age or older and of a model year after 1948 and has been altered from the manufacturer’s original design or has a body constructed from non-original materials.
 Or,
 Was manufactured to resemble a vehicle that is 25 years of age or older and of a model year after 1948; and has been altered from the manufacturer’s original design or has a body constructed from non-original materials.
- C.** The vehicle title/record must carry a brand of “custom vehicle” prior to applying for a custom vehicle license plate.

III. GENERAL INFORMATION FOR STREET RODS:

- A. The model year and year of manufacture that the body of a street rod resembles is the model year and year of manufacture listed on the certificate of title, regardless of when the vehicle was actually manufactured.
- B. Street rod license plates may only be issued for motor vehicles with a model year of 1948 or older and has been altered from the manufacturer's original design or has a body constructed from non-original materials.

Or,

Was manufactured after 1948 to resemble a vehicle of a model year of 1948 or older and has been altered from the manufacturer's original design or has a body constructed from non-original materials.
- C. The vehicle title/record must carry a brand of "street rod" prior to applying for a street rod license plate.

IV. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STREET RODS AND CUSTOM VEHICLES:

- A. The vehicle title/record must carry a brand of "custom vehicle" or "street rod" prior to applying for a custom vehicle or street rod license plate. Once branded, an accurately completed form [HSMV 83045, Application for Registration of a Street Rod, Custom Vehicle, Horseless Carriage or Antique \(Permanent\)](#), is required for the issuance of a custom vehicle or street rod license plate.
- B. Proof of Florida insurance is required. Refer to DMS Procedure [RS-36](#) for additional insurance requirements.
- C. Fees: Submit the regular tax fees shown in the Tax Due and Credit Manual using class code 95, trust fund fee from the Class Code/Fee Chart, Processing fee, Original License Plate fee, Decal on Demand fee and Service fee (add Branch fee, if applying through a county branch office). Refer to [Registration Fees and Flat Taxes Distribution Chart](#) for applicable fees.

V. RENEWALS AND TRANSFERS OF CUSTOM VEHICLE OR STREET ROD LICENSE PLATES:

Renewals and transfers may be processed through any local Tax Collector's office or license plate agency. Custom vehicle and street rod license plates can only be transferred to a motor vehicle that meets the qualifications of a custom vehicle or street rod.

VI. REPLACEMENT LICENSE PLATES:

Applications for replacement license plates may be processed by the local tax collector's office or county license plate agency.

The following is required:

- A. Form [HSMV 83146, Application for Replacement License Plate, Validation Decal or Parking Permit](#), accurately completed.
- B. A copy of the vehicle registration certificate. Refer to DMS Procedure [RS-06](#) for additional information and fees.
- C. **When the customer has reported the license plate or validation decal as stolen to a law enforcement agency and provides a police report prepared in response to a report of a stolen license plate or decal, such plate must be replaced at no charge. A law enforcement agency care, containing the case number for the stolen report of the license plate or decal, may be accepted in lieu of the report. Comments must be reflected in the FRVIS comment area to include the law enforcement agency name and the stolen report case number.**

If a license plate or decal is replaced using code "SP," Stolen with a Police Report, a copy of the police report or law enforcement agency card containing the case number for the stolen report, must be attached to the required form HSMV 83146.

If the customer does not provide the police report or law enforcement agency card containing the case number for the stolen report, fees are required along with HSMV 83146.
